# 观光景点:







- ▼安门广场-位于北京市中心,可容百万人举行集会是世界名城中最大的广场。
- 故宫-又名紫禁城,是明清两代皇帝住过的皇宫。它位于北京市中心,面积达72万平方米,是世界上规模最大的宫殿建筑群。故宫可以分为两大部分,南为工作区,即外朝,北为生活区,即 内廷。外朝内廷的所有建筑排列在中轴线上,东西对称,秩序井然。
- 天坛-中国现代最大坛庙建筑,它乃明、清两代帝王祀天祈谷的坛庙,主要包括祈年殿、皇宇、 回音壁、围丘、斋宫等。
- 居庸关万里长城-长城全长6000多公里,是世界上最伟大的建筑之一。长城始建于秦始皇时期, 经过历代的增补修筑,现在我们能看到的长城几乎都是明代所建。
- 王府井大街-全长约1600米的王府井大街是最受北京人民喜爱的商业区,也是全国著名的购物 天堂。王府井大街作为北京的寸金之地,每天的销售额可以说是"日进斗金"。
- 东华门小吃街-是城中颇负盛名的北京小吃夜市。90多个打理得干净得体的小摊,叫卖着汉、 回两族不同风味的碰头食品。
- 北京明皇宮蜡像馆 是展示中国明朝历史的大型人文景观。宫有二十六个独立逼真的场景,三 百七十四尊栩栩如生、光彩照人的人物蜡像。
- 颐和园-原名清漪园,始建于公元1750年;1860年的第二次鸦片战争中,清漪园被英法联军烧 毁;1886年,清政府挪用海军,军费等款项重修,并于两年后改名颐和园,作为慈禧太后晚年 的顾养之地。
- 鸟巢国家体育场 鸟巢"是2008年北京奥运会主体育场,乃可容纳9.1万人的体育场。
- 水立方游泳馆-因表面看如一个装满水的立方体所以俗称"水立方"为奥运主要的水上项目比
- 秀水街- 作为中国早的自由市场和最著名的商业品牌,有着近三十年的历史,与中国的改革开放 相伴相生。
- 世贸天阶-优雅的阶梯广场,现代气息的步行街,以及绚丽宏伟的天幕奇观。

# Tourist Attractions:



### BEIJING

- Tian An Men Square Which located at the center of Beijing. Tian An Men Square is the largest square in the world and can hold about one million people in the same time. It is surrounded by the Forbidden City in the north, the Great Hall of People in the west and museums of Chinese History and Chinese Revolution in the east.
- Forbidden City The largest and best preserved collection of ancient buildings in China. The complex is divided into two sections - Inner Court - the living quarters and Outer Court - the working area.
- Temple of Heaven Is a place where the Ming & Qing Dynasty went to worship Heaven and pray for
- Great Wall Is a series of stone and fortifications in China, built, rebuilt, and maintained between 5th. Century and 16th Century to protect the northern borders of Chinese Empire from Xiongnu attacks during the rule of successive dynasties
- Wang Fu Jin It's the most famous commercial district selling daily necessities, hardware, electrical items, garments, jewellery, diamonds, gold and silver etc.
- Dong Hua Men Food Street The largest night market in Beijing selling varieties of snack from all
- Ming Dynasty Wax Museum Is the interpretation of history and culture of the Ming Dynasty major tourist and cultural attractions. Has twenty six separate realistic scenes and three hundred seventy-four
- Summer Palace Formerly known as Qing Yi Park, built in Qing Emperor Qianlong began fifteen years (1750). In the Second Opium War, fire burned by British and French troops. Rebuilt in 1860, as a recuperate relegated palace of Empress Dowager Cixi.
- Beijing 2008 Olympic Stadium Is the main stadium of the 29th Beijing Olympic Games. The National Stadium in Beijing, the main stadium for the 2008 Olympic Games, is dubbed the "bird's nest" because of its innovative grid formation.
- The National Aquatic Centre Also called the "Water Cube", The center will be the venue for swimming, diving, synchronized swimming and water-polo final during the Olympic Games.
- XiuShui Market- has the history of near 30 years as Chinese early free market and the most famous commercial trademark, the reforming and opening up with China accompanies appearance livelihood.
- The Place-LED Screen which you may enjoy with fashion shops, restaurants, bars and other gathering place

## CHENGDE

• Little Potala Place- The temple was originally built for minority group leaders from all over China to celebrate the 60th birthday of the Qing Dynasty Emperor Qianlong (1711-1799).
