大阪

- 大阪城堡 - 是大阪的象征, 它包括十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑。
- 日清杯面发明馆 - 是透过有关速成拉面的各式各样的展示和体验工作室等, 来了解关于发明与发现的重要和满足冒险心理, 是一边享受一边能学习的体验型博物馆。
- 心斋桥·道顿堀 - 是大阪最知名、最热闹的商业购物区。这里珠宝店、百货店、餐饮店、特色商铺林立。远在江户时, 这里就已形成了购物商圈, 距今已380年的历史, 直到今天, 这里依然热闹非凡, 处处洋溢着时尚、繁华、美丽和激情, 是来大阪旅游必到的地方

神户

- 神户渔人码头 Harbour Land - 设有大型商场及游乐场。Harbour Land 著瞩目的是一座亮著灿烂灯饰的摩天轮, 让您完全投入浪漫情怀。
- 神户菊正宗清酒工厂 - 菊正宗创业日本年号万治2年。它的历史悠久, 是日本清酒界的老牌企业之一。

京都

- 清水寺 - 始建于778年, 早于京都建都, 是一座有着悠久历史的寺院, 整座建筑完全不用铁打钉锁。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店, 摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品, 陶瓷, 日本娃娃等, 不胜枚举。
- 稻荷神社 - 每年都有大量的香客前来神社祭拜求取农作丰收、生意兴隆、交通安全, 使得该神社成为京都地区香火最盛的神社之一。另外, 起源于江户时代的习俗, 前来此地许愿的人们往往会捐款在神社境内竖立一座鸟居来表达对神明的敬意, 使得伏见稻荷大社的范围内竖有数量惊人的大小鸟居, 而以「千本鸟居」之名闻名日本全国乃至海外。目前现存的鸟居, 最早可以追溯到明治年间。
- 祇园艺妓街 - 是京都的一个艺伎区, 这里在现在可以说成是京都最具有代表性的地区。在白天, 这里可以找到7世纪的餐馆和茶馆, 许多的游客都喜欢在这里休闲消遣, 在路上漫步, 你还可以看到有行色匆匆的艺妓, 也许她们就会和你擦肩而过。

箱根

- 平和公园 - 内有各种四季植物花卉和松树, 也有一座大型释迦牟尼之塔。
- 箱根大涌谷 - 为300年前火山爆发的火山口, 每当起风时, 带着硫磺味的浓烟弥漫期间时, 形成特殊景观。登上山顶, 有用火山温泉煮熟的「黑鸡蛋」, 据日本人说吃一个可长寿7年。
- 富士山 - 富士山海拔 3776 米, 是日本第一高峰。它气势雄伟, 为其它山峰所不及, 呈圆锥形的山姿十分优美, 常常被用来作为绘画和文学的创作题材, 它作为日本的象征, 名扬全世界。
- 芦之湖海盜船 - 乘海盜船游览背倚着富士山的芦之湖, 湖山相映, 不同的季节有不同的景致和情趣。

东京

- 迪斯尼乐园 - 在迪斯尼正门的中心, 可以看到高耸的“灰姑娘城”这座主建筑, 然后在它的周围还建造了多种主题的游乐场和游乐馆, 有冒险宫、世界著名故事、传说宫、有风景宫、闲游宫、宇宙宫、幻想宫等。在东京迪斯尼乐园里还可以看到大型的游行表演, 这些表演让您身同进入迪斯尼童话世界、并流连忘返。
- 浅草雷门观音寺 - 建于7世纪的佛庙, 其象征物是风雷神门, 上面挂着写有“雷门”两个字的大红灯笼, 这里每天都有前来参拜的观光客, 终年熙熙攘攘。您也可在该寺前的热闹街道“仲见世”购物, 此处满布出售纪念品的小店及当地小吃的日式店铺。
- 皇居二重桥 - 位于东京市中心, 护城河和石墙围绕著广大的绿地。日本皇室现居於此。皇居前的大广场称为皇居外苑, 游客可由皇居外苑观赏二重桥, 这两座桥是通往皇宫内的广场的入口处。
- 银座 - 与巴黎的香榭丽舍大街、纽约的第五大街齐名, 是世界三大繁华中心之一。银座是许多百年老铺与本土品牌的发祥地, 它是日本高级、名牌、流行、品味、信用、货真价实、憧憬、时尚的代名词。

OSAKA

- **Sinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - a covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop.
- **CupNoodles Museum** - This is a museum which enables us to experience the "Creative Thinking" of the inventor and founder of Nissin Foods, Momofuku Ando, through its exhibitions. Here, you can enjoy seeing, touching, having fun, gathering clues about invention and discovery, and finding your own "Creative Thinking".

KOBE

- **Kobe Harbour Land** - a premier commercial and sightseeing destination on the site of the former Japan National Railways Minatogawa Cargo Station.
- **Ku-Masamune Sake Brewery** - It is a museum of Sake that tells you the secret of traditional sake brewing techniques of the Tanba region. You can also try tasting different kinds of sake here for free.

KYOTO

- **Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple** - The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.
- **Fushimi Inari Shrine** - is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari. famous for its thousands (over 10,000) of closely-spaced orange torii gates that wind over the hills of Inariyama beyond the entrance to the shrine. Inari was seen as the patron of business, and merchants and manufacturers have traditionally worshipped Inari.
- **Gion Geisha District** - is Kyoto's most famous geisha district, with its high concentration of traditional wooden merchant houses.

HAKONE

- **Peace Park** - is a very beautiful and calm place, with Buddha's relics.
- **Owakudani** - an area with active volcanic zone where sulphurous fumes, its "Black jewel eggs" cooked in the area's thermal heat sources, are a Hakone specialty.
- **MT Fuji** - is the highest mountain in Japan at 3,776.24 m. An active stratovolcano that last erupted in 1707-08.
- **Lake Ashi Pirate Ship** - was formed in the caldera of Mount Hakone after the volcano's last eruption 3000 years ago. And the boat ride could enjoy dreams and romance while gazing upon the delights of Mt. Fuji.

TOKYO

- **Tokyo Disneyland** - Tokyo Disneyland was the first Disney resort to be opened outside of America. The park is divided into 7 areas and the centerpiece of Tokyo Disneyland, like most Disney resorts, is Cinderella's Castle. Tokyo Disneyland places regularly as one of the top three most visited theme parks in the world.
- **Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple)** - The temple is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- **Imperial Palace** - formerly the Tokugawa family's residence, was opened in the Meiji Restoration and later re-named as the Imperial Palace, and it's famous for the Nijubashi Bridge in front of the main entrance.
- **Ginza** - Is Tokyo's most famous up market shopping, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants and cafes. Also one of the most expensive, upscale areas in Tokyo which is jewelled with upscale retail like as Louis Vutton, Chanel, Hermes, De Beers, Tiffany and Apple.
