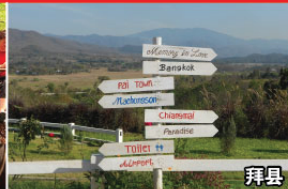

清迈

- **素贴山双龙寺**-参观双龙寺, 清迈的最重要和最明显的地标, 俯瞰城市森林山为背景。走近寺庙是徒步攀登陡峭的楼梯comprinsinf的290步骤。寺庙的金色宝塔包含一个神圣的佛舍利, 并吸引了来自世界各地一年四季佛教香客。
- **体验皇帝餐含表演**-享受一个晚上Khantoke的晚餐, 泰国北部的风格, 习惯, 吃的食品虽然选择不多但可是无限供应, 而你坐在垫子上, 在地板上的大拼盘。一边用餐一边让自己沉浸在北部的文化表演, 包括迷人丰LEP (泰国手指舞), 拉姆, DAB (泰国剑舞) 丰 (泰国蜡烛舞Thiean), 和拉姆黄 (群舞选择)。
- **大象野生动物园** - 你可近距离触摸小象, 了解大象的生活, 观赏大象表演, 大象冲凉, 大象画画, 还有骑大象, 坐牛车及乘竹筏欣赏自然风光. 在这里可观赏到如何训练大象, 并观看大象的精彩表演, 亦可坐在背上装有木椅的大象, 牛车, 竹筏, 骑乘时有专业工作人员随行。
- **兰花蝴蝶园** - 展出花朵的所有品种, 形状及颜色价格从数元至数十万, 为罕见的外来物种。
- **3D错觉艺术馆**-世上最大 3D 艺术馆 (又称“天堂艺术”), 由韩国人 Jang Kyu Suk 投资 6000 万泰铢 (约 1188.8 万元) 建立并运营。该新建的 3D 艺术馆, 共三层, 规模堪称世界最大, 拥有逾130幅3D墙上绘画, 其中亮点包括陆地动物、海底世界、灭绝动物、沙漠, 以及举世闻名的法老坟墓。该馆内的绘画有创造性、富想像力、色彩绚烂多彩; 该馆注重以互动的艺术形式发散游客思维, 激发大众想象力。
- **皇家花园**-环境优美、绿草如茵, 园内有金碧辉煌、富有兰纳王朝特色的泰式楼阁, 有形态可爱、造型各异的花果卡通形象, 还有数十座主题庭园场馆, 展出的花卉包括泰国兰花、中国杜鹃花、不丹蓝罂粟、荷兰郁金香等。这里曾在2006年举办过国际园艺博览会, 又于2011年为庆祝泰国国王的诞辰及登基60周年再度举行盛会。
- **家庭手工业区**-集中所有清迈的文化成就, 没有比他们的手工艺品更加显著。清迈是泰国的主要中心, 闻名优质手工艺品。号称全世界最大家庭工业 (皮革, 土特产, 燕窝)

拜县

- **二战纪念大桥** - 距离拜县9km, 是日本兵在二战期间所建, 用于纪念二战。这里是一个热门的拍摄点, 尽管桥不起眼, 但有人为它装饰了一些有趣的元素, 使之变得有情调起来。此外, 在这也可以看日落, 有河水映着落日余晖, 波光粼粼, 也很漂亮, 但是没有登高望远的感觉。
- **云来观景台**-是俯瞰拜县全景的最佳之处, 以日出而闻名。
- **南湖寺庙** - 有四百余年历史, 庙内供奉着一尊神圣的清盛时期佛像, 相传多年前有个流浪和尚来到此庙, 发现有清澈的泉水从佛像的头颅中涌出, 源源不断, 此后民众都视其为圣水, 将水带回家中, 用来祈求平安。
- **南湖山地村** - 一个由国民党老兵占据的村庄。村里大多是原国民党93、95师留下的官兵和他们的后裔。泰国政府让他们留在这里, 但却不给他们合法身份。他们大多数人没有身份证, 他们拿的是难民证, 离开湄宏颂府就要办通行证。这个村落在去往寻找瀑布的路上会路过, 一片中国客家群居, 到处都有汉语中文, 人们普遍会汉语。还建了一些中国风民宿。

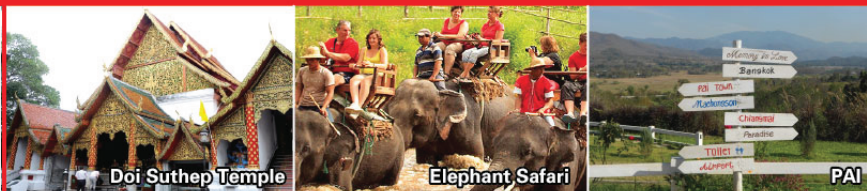

CHIANGMAI

- **Doi Suthep Temple** - There are about 300 steps to climb. The reward is more than worth the effort. You will see a beautiful Buddhist Temple and you will experience a beautiful view. While climbing the stairs, you should pay attention to the giant dragons on the sides of the stairs (they appear already downstairs; see the right hand side picture).
- **KHANTOKE DINNER** - Enjoy an evening out by having a Khantoke Dinner, the customary northern Thai style of eating with food being served in large platters at low tables while you sit on mats on the floor. As you enjoy your meal, let yourself be entertained by a selection of northern cultural performances including the charming Fon Lep (Thai Finger Dance), Ram Dab (Thai Sword Dance), Fon Thiean (Thai Candle Dance), and Ram Wong (Group Dance).
- **Elephant Safari** - Enjoy a elephant show, you can also experience elephant ride, ox cart, and bamboo rafting with professional guide.
- **Orchid Butterfly Farm** - On display are a profusion of blooms of all varieties, shapes, colours and prices from a few baht for the common trains to a few hundred thousand for the rare and exotic species.
- **3D Art in Paradise** - Catch the petals falling off Van Gogh's Sunflowers at the Art in Paradise Chiang Mai 3D Art Museum. There, art breaks out of the frame and seems to reach out to touch you. Founded by an artist, the motto of this art gallery is: be fun, be active, be creative, touch your fantastic world.
- **Royal Flora Garden** - is a horticultural exhibition in the city of Chiang Mai where visitors can admire thousands of species of trees and flowers on 80 hectares of landscaped gardens. The park is named after Thailand's national flower Ratchaphruek (Cassia fistula or golden shower tree) with its beautiful yellow blossom. One of the park's highlights is the orchid pavilion with its countless species of orchids in many colors.
- **SAN KHAM PHANG VILLAGE(HOME INDUSTRIES)** - Knows as largest handicraft village in the world. You may get to know more about thailand product through this village. (Leather Shop, Sweety Shop , Bird Nest Shop)

PAI

- **Pai Memorial Bridge** - The Memorial Bridge over Pai river has become one of many fascinating tourist attractions of Pai. The Memorial Bridge was made of iron and was built in 1942 by the Japanese to transport weapons and provisions to Myanmar (Burma) during World War II. It is located at kilometre marker 88 on highway 1095, Mae Malai-Pai Road.
- **Yun Lai View Point** - one can enjoy a delicious pot of green tea, a gorgeous view of the natural beauty surrounding Pai, and an everlasting sense of quietness that is often hard to find in Thailand.
- **Santichon Chinese Yunnan Village** - Village settled by Yunnanese hill tribes who crossed the border in the middle of the 20th century to escape Communist rule. Shops selling different Chinese teas with varying health properties, and other interesting oddities include a human-powered Ferris wheel.
- **Wat Nam Hu Temple** - It is a place of Phra Un Muaeng Monument which is Singha Sarm Budha (Lanna art). The appearance like Pang Marn Wichai (Lord Budha posture) and made of bronze metal.
