岷港

岷港

- **婆纳山城** - 搭乘2009年被列入健力士纪录全球最长及最高不停站单缆车, 缆车长5801, 眼前景象犹如身处仙境之中。婆纳有辽阔的自然林, 溪泉纵横其间, 天气晴朗时, 站在主山顶, 可以看见岷港市、容橘湾、美溪海等整个宽广空间, 犹如一幅巨型山水画。
- **占婆博物馆** - 建成于1915年。博物馆外貌古色古香, 馆内展览了约三百多件自七世纪至十六世纪历代的占族舞女石像及珍贵占族文化遗物, 包括十间不同的展览室。占婆雕刻博物馆以占巴的建筑风格而建。
- **美山圣地** - 1999年已列为世界文化遗产。修建于公元500年, 曾是统治越南中南部地区长达14个世纪的印度教占婆王朝心脏地区。美山与山无关, 是越文“MY SON”音译。公元4世纪末, 占婆国王下令在此修建第一座木制结构的寺庙。占婆王国与柬埔寨真腊王国、印尼河陵王国并称“东南亚三大古代王国”, 因而美山圣地与柬埔寨的吴哥窟、印尼的婆罗浮屠佛塔齐名, 占有极其重要的历史地位。有“小吴哥窟”之称。美山遗址有三大建筑群, 其建造和雕刻风格与越南其它地区的建筑差异十分明显。
- **山茶半岛** - 被称为岷港之肺, 有原始森林4370公顷, 半岛上尚峦起伏, 林木繁茂, 并有鸟兽出没, 已被划为森林保护区。山上的灵应寺树立着东南亚最高观音佛像, 站在灵应寺可以一览整座岷港城市和大海, 景色迷人让人流连忘返。

会安

- **会安古镇** - 1999年已列为世界文化遗产。古镇古韵吸引大量的西方游客, 在这里满街都是来休闲度假的西方人。会安还是越南华人的聚居地, 有“小丽江”之称。这里中国元素随处可见。在这里你还可以量身定做越南的国服“奥岱”, 既便宜又交货快捷, 远近闻名, 是游客最爱消费之一。
- **日本桥** - 西元1593年兴建, 由日本人建造的木造拱桥。桥上有屋顶供遮蔽用, 北侧建有小寺庙。依据某个故事的说法, 这座桥是猴年兴建, 狗年完成, 因此两侧出入口分别由猴子与狗守护。

顺化

- **启定皇陵** - 1920年开始建造, 直到启定帝驾崩六年之后(1931年)才完工。建筑风格采用东西合璧, 远看整座皇陵很像一座气份神秘的欧式城堡, 与其他皇陵大不相同。内部地板铺着彩色的琉璃瓦, 墙上有巨幅祥龙壁画, 内庭的左右两侧有花磁砖与碎玻璃拼成的彩色壁画, 天花板则以黑白色调的云龙装饰而成, 叙述著各种不同的故事主题。
- **紫禁城** - 於1802年至1945年阮朝之皇都, 阮朝开国君王於1804年始建, 费时30年完工。就像中国的北京紫禁城有异曲同工之妙。联合国科教文组织於1994年认定紫禁城为『世界文化遗产』, 肯定其观光价值, 您会发现古迹上所有题字都是我们所熟悉的中文文字, 这是因为中国与越南的历史渊源深厚。乘坐人力三轮车游古城周边。
- **灵姥寺** - 此寺建於香江畔的山丘上, 寺前有福缘塔於1844年由阮朝第三位皇帝启定皇帝所建, 其所在位置据说为龙脉之首, 不仅地理风水好连风景视野都是上乘之选。

古芝地道

- **古芝地道** - 此地道长逾200公里, 为越南抗美时期的越共游击队之地下根据地。游客至此可亲身感受到越共打游击战之苦, 并体验战争现场的气氛。

胡志明

- **红教堂 (圣母大教堂)** - 因使用红砖建造, 又称红教堂, 是胡志明市最著名的地标。教堂建成于1883年, 为法国殖民时期留下的纪念品。建筑造型匀称, 庄严宏伟, 两座40米高的钟楼塔尖直冲云霄, 是仿照巴黎圣母院钟楼的设计。
- **邮政大楼** - 建于19世纪末, 由法国建筑师设计, 大厅内部装饰华丽, 圆顶极富古典气息。这座邮局至今仍在用。
- **市政廳** - 胡志明市政府大楼即原西贡市政厅, 是一座具有浓烈法国风格的建筑。

美拖

- **美拖** - 船游湄公河, 参观泰山岛及在水果园品尝越南之特产时节水果, 并欣赏当地传统民谣等。之后参观生产椰子糖工厂, 岛上居民区, 手工艺品加工处, 养蜜蜂处和品尝蜜糖茶。然后乘坐小船沿小河畅游再转接大船回岸, 午餐品尝美拖地名的一越式油泡象鱼。

Tourist Attractions:



DANANG

- **Ba Na Hills** – The Ba Na Cable Car holds the world record for longest non-stop single track cable car at 5801 metres in length. You get an amazing view, waterfalls, streams, dense forest and wide vistas across Danang to the sea. the scenery will be worth the journey.
- **Museum of Cham Sculpture** - The Museum of Cham Sculpture was built in 1915 with the financial support of the French Far-East Research Institute in Vietnam. This museum houses the most extensive collection of Cham art worldwide.
- **My Son Sanctuary** - The Mỹ Sơn temple complex is regarded one of the foremost Hindu temple complexes in Southeast Asia and is the foremost heritage site of this nature in Vietnam. It is often compared with other historical temple complexes in Southeast Asia, such as Borobudur of Java in Indonesia, Angkor Wat of Cambodia, Bagan of Myanmar and Ayutthaya of Thailand. As of 1999, Mỹ Sơn has been recognized by UNESCO as a world heritage site.
- **Son Tra Peninsula** - a fragile gem in beautiful Da Nang. Enjoy the grand view of the East Sea and Danang City. Stop to visit Linh Ung Pagoda, the pagoda features a giant white statue of the Goddess of Mercy, which is a now popular sightseeing spot in Da Nang City.

HOI AN

- **Hoi An Ancient Town** - Is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a South-East Asian trading port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. Its buildings and its street plan reflect the influences, both indigenous and foreign, that have combined to produce this unique heritage site.
- **Japanese Covered Bridge** - This beautiful little bridge is emblematic of Hoi An. A bridge was first constructed here in the 1590s by the Japanese community in order to link them with the Chinese quarters across the stream. The entrances to the bridge are guarded by weathered statues: a pair of monkeys on one side, a pair of dogs on the other. Another tale says that construction of the bridge started in the year of the monkey and was finished in the year of the dog.

HUE

- **Tomb of Khai Dinh**– This hillside monument is a synthesis of Vietnamese and European elements. Most of the tomb's grandiose exterior is covered in blackened concrete, creating an unexpectedly Gothic air, while the interiors resemble an explosion of colourful mosaic. Khai Dinh was the penultimate emperor of Vietnam, from 1916 to 1925, and widely seen as a puppet of the French. The construction of his flamboyant tomb took 11 years.
- **Hue Imperial Citadel** - The Citadel of Hue (Kinh thanh hue), is a large fortress built in the 17TH century (year 1805) mandated by Emperor Gia Long in the city of Hue in Central Vietnam. This huge and magnificent monument has been designed combining the concepts of Chinese geomancy (the best example is The forbidden city in Beijing) and the military principles of the French architect Sébastien de Vauban. The resulting final set are precious palaces, beautiful temples melted between walls, ramparts and moats, which coexist in total harmony.
- **Thien Mu Pagoda** - Built in 1601 between a river and a pine forest, the **Thien Mu Pagoda** ("Heavenly Lady Pagoda") in Hue is one of the oldest and prettiest religious buildings in the country.

CU CHI

- **Cu Chi Tunnel** –Where human knowledge has been enriched by experiencing an web-like tunnels system of more than 200km in length which used to be the shelters of guerrillas during the war against American troops.

HO CHI MINH

- **The Hundred Years Red Cathedral (Notre Dame Cathedral)** – With her two 40 meter towers topped with iron spires is one of Ho Chi Minh City's major landmarks. The cathedral's red bricks and coloured glass windows were imported from France. With full services in both Vietnamese and English are held every Sunday morning.
- **The People's Committee Hall** – Was built in 1902-1908 in a French colonial style for the then city of Saigon.
- **The Old Post Office** – Is Saigon's French-styled post office. Built between 1886 and 1891, the ochre - coloured building has a glass canopy, ceiling fans, and enormous wall maps of "Saigon et Ses Environs".

MY THO

- **My Tho (Mekong River)** – Boat ride to Mekong River with islet stop at Thoi Son to taste seasonal fruits, enjoy traditional folk songs. Then, visit the authentic life of the local and challenge your bargaining power at cottage handicraft shops. An adventurous sampan ride in palm shading creeks will be the next experience of the riverside region. Lunch to be served with the Mekong Delta specialty – **Deep Fried Elephant Ear Fish**.
