北京

- 天安门广场-位于北京市中心,可容百万人举行集会是世界名城中最大的广场。
- 故宫-又名紫禁城,是明清两代皇帝住过的皇宫。它位于北京市中心,面积达72万平方米,是世界上规模最大的宫殿建筑群。故宫可以分为两大部分,南为工作区,即外朝,北为生活区,即内廷。外朝内廷的所有建筑排列在中轴线上,东西对称,秩序井然。
- 天坛-中国现代最大坛庙建筑,它乃明、清两代帝王祀天祈谷的坛庙,主要包括祈年殿、皇宇、回音壁、圜丘、斋宫等。
- 居庸关万里长城-长城全长6000多公里,是世界上最伟大的建筑之一。长城始建于秦始皇时期,经过历代的增补修筑,现在我们能看到的长城几乎都是明代所建。
- 王府井大街-全长约1600米的王府井大街是最受北京人民喜爱的商业区,也是全国著名的购物天堂。王府井大街作为北京的寸金之地,每天的销售额可以说是“日进斗金”。
- 东华门小吃街-是城中颇负盛名的北京小吃夜市。90多个打理得干净得体的小摊,叫卖着汉、回两族不同风味的碰头食品。
- 颐和园-原名清漪园,始建于公元1750年;1860年的第二次鸦片战争中,清漪园被英法联军烧毁;1886年,清政府挪用海军,军费等款项重修,并于两年后改名颐和园,作为慈禧太后晚年的颐养之地。
- 鸟巢国家体育场-鸟巢是2008年北京奥运会主体育场,乃可容纳9.1万人的体育场。
- 水立方游泳馆-因表面看如一个装满水的立方体所以俗称“水立方”为奥运主要的水上项目比赛场馆。
- 天云山-北京平谷天云山 旅游风景区位于北京市平谷区黄松峪乡黄土梁,距离京东大溶洞10公里。这里峰峦叠嶂,怪石嶙峋;山林茂密,空谷鸟鸣;既有流泉飞瀑的灵性,又有古藤野花的烂漫,山峰奇秀,如诗如画,鬼斧神工。好一个北方的张家界,神奇的天云山。
- 玻璃栈道-是全国最长的高空玻璃栈道,全长160米。
- 798 艺术区-艺术区的名字是由北京国营电子工业老厂区的名称沿用而来,如今,798除了数字本来含义以外,一般专指北京798艺术区,在798艺术区的发展过程中形成了798共识,因此798也指这一艺术区引申出的一种文化概念,以及LOFT这种时尚的居住与工作方式,亦称798方式。

BEIJING

- **Tian An Men Square** - Which located at the center of Beijing. Tian An Men Square is the largest square in the world and can hold about one million people in the same time. It is surrounded by the Forbidden City in the north, the Great Hall of People in the west and museums of Chinese History and Chinese Revolution in the east.
- **Forbidden City** - The largest and best preserved collection of ancient buildings in China. The complex is divided into two sections - Inner Court - the living quarters and Outer Court - the working area.
- **Temple of Heaven** - Is a place where the Ming & Qing Dynasty went to worship Heaven and pray for good harvest.
- **Great Wall** - Is a series of stone and fortifications in China, built, rebuilt and maintained between 5th Century and 16th Century to protect the northern borders of Chinese Empire from Xiongnu attacks during the rule of successive dynasties.
- **Wang Fu Jin** - It's the most famous commercial district selling daily necessities, hardware, electrical items, garments, jewellery, diamonds, gold and silver etc.
- **Dong Hua Men Food Street** - The largest night market in Beijing selling varieties of snack from all over the country.
- **Summer Palace** - Formerly known as Qing Yi Park, built in Qing Emperor Qianlong began fifteen years (1750). In the Second Opium War, fire burned by British and French troops. Rebuilt in 1860, as a recuperate relegated palace of Empress Dowager Cixi.
- **Beijing 2008 Olympic Stadium** - Is the main stadium of the 29th Beijing Olympic Games. The National Stadium in Beijing, the main stadium for the 2008 Olympic Games, is dubbed the "bird's nest" because of its innovative grid formation.
- **The National Aquatic Centre** - Also called the "Water Cube", The center will be the venue for swimming, diving, synchronized swimming and water-polo final during the Olympic Games.
- **Tian Yun Shan** - also known as North of the Zhangjiajie. Famous of it beautiful natural scenery like peaks, rugged rock formations, dense forests, birds Valley and etc.
- **Glass Walkway** - it is the longest walkway with the length of 160m in China.
