## 富士山

- 富士山五合目-富士山从山脚到山顶, 共划分为10个阶段, 每个阶段是一个“合目”, 由山脚下出发到半山腰称为五合目, 由五合目再往上攀登, 便是六合目、七合目, 直至山顶的十合目。每合目都设有供游人休息的地方, 巴士最高可上到2305米的“五合目”。
- 忍野八海 - 由富士高山雪水渗入地底后涌出的八个池子而形成的特别景观, 是白佳名泉之一。加上以富士山为背景的美丽景致, 确实令人沉迷。
- 和平公园 - 内有各种四季植物花卉和松树, 也有一座大型释迦牟尼之塔。

## 东京

- 新宿 - 东京都政府大楼、高楼大厦林立的事务所一条街。以购物、娱乐综合设施为中心的新宿, 被誉为不夜城的歌舞伎町为中心的日本少有的娱乐区。
- 东京都厅 - 位于东京新宿新区, 是属于纪念性高层建筑比较有代表性的例子。
- 明治神宫 - 供奉明治天皇和昭宪皇太后灵位, 是日本神道教最重要的神社, 有着东京都内最大的一片绿地。明治神宫由入口处耸立的日本最大的鸟居、“升”字型大参道、大殿、宝物殿构成。明治神宫内苑的植物根据四季更迭呈现出不同景致。
- 皇居二重桥 - 位于皇居正门前, 因护城河水深, 旧桥较低, 所以在桥上再搭一座桥, 称为二重桥。二重桥是游客的必到之地。也是通向皇宫的特别通道。在新年和天皇生日时, 公众可通过二重桥进入皇宫并接受天皇的问候。
- 银座 - 银座是许多百年老铺与本土品牌的发祥地, 它是日本高级、名牌、流行、品味、信用、货真价实、憧憬、时尚的代名词。
- 涉谷 - 是东京最繁忙、最有特色的区域之一, 也是是东京首屈一指的以青少年为对象的商业中心, 著名的“涉谷109”大楼就在这里, 它已经超出了购物中心, 成为涩谷GAL系流行时尚的代表。
- 成田山新胜寺 - 是真言宗智山派大本山, 作为日本不动尊信仰的总府祈愿场吸引了很多信众。宽大的寺院内并立著各种新旧建筑, 江戸时代中期~末期的建筑仁王门、三重塔、释迦堂、额堂、光明堂共5棟已被指定为重要文化遺產。
- 台场 - 尤其受年轻人的青睐。台场主要的观光地是台场海滨公园, 这里有东京都内唯一的沙滩, 滨海沿线有散步道可以观赏海景, 优美的景色吸引了诸多有日剧在这里取景拍摄。
- 高达广场 - 最吸引人的莫过于18m的1:1元祖高达RX78, 许而位于高达后身的台场购物中心七楼更是有高达主题展馆, 这里拥有世界上最齐全的高达模型, 各个阶段, 各种型号应有尽有, 可谓是一饱眼福的不二去处。

## 伊豆

- 竹林小径 - 是中伊豆的又一著名自然景观, 素有伊豆小京都之稱, 是一條充滿自然清新情趣的散步小路。竹林小徑長400米, 自朱紅色的桂橋到瀧下橋之間, 沿修善寺溫泉街中部流淌的桂川沿岸蜿蜒而行, 曲徑通幽。
- 修禅寺 - 修禅寺是修善寺溫泉區的著名寺院和觀光景點, 據傳修禅寺是弘法大師空海於公元807年開基創建的古刹, 歷史悠久。
- 独钻之汤 - 独钻之湯位於桂川河心的清流中, 是修善寺溫泉的發祥之地。據傳, 當年弘法大師在此用其独钻杵(佛具的一種)在桂川清流中的岩石上用一擊, 頓時靈泉湧噴, 為後人造就了不朽的名泉。
- 日枝神社 - 日枝神社緊鄰修禅寺, 是一處僻靜的神社, 相傳由弘法大師所建。由山下前往日枝神社有一條參道, 參道和神社內處處古木參天, 松樹、榉樹、杉樹等鬱鬱蔥蔥。

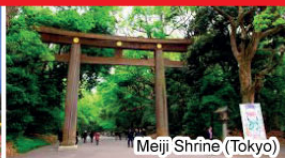

**MT. FUJI**

- **Mount Fuji** – Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times. This 3776 meters high, dormant volcano is world renowned for its symmetry and serenity.
- **Oshino Hakkai** – is underground water from Mt. Fuji. It begins with the snow on the top of Mt. Fuji. The water travel over 80 years, and finally spring at Oshino Hakkai.
- **Peace Park**- The purpose of the construction of this park is to convey the tragedy of the atomic bomb to the next generation, not tragedy, pray for world peace.

**TOKYO**

- **Tokyo Metropolitan Government of Tokyo** - Japan is home to the headquarters, it was the tallest building in Japan, after being caricatured as "bubble tower. Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building Governor to be completed by the time of construction (Tokyo directorate) Shunichi Suzuki, by architect Kenzo Tange design.
- **Shinjuku** – is one of the 23 wards of Tokyo, but the name commonly refers just to the large entertainment, business and shopping area around Shinjuku Station. Handling more than two million passengers each day.
- **Meiji Shrine** - Dedicated to Emperor Meiji and Empress Empress Shōken souls, is Japan's most important Shinto shrine in Tokyo has the largest piece of green space.
- **Shibuya**- Shibuya is one of Tokyo's most colourful and busy districts, packed with shopping, dining and nightclubs serving swarms of visitors that come to the district every day.
- **Imperial Palace** - A large park area surrounded by moats and massive stone walls in the centre of Tokyo, It is the residence of Japan's Imperial Family.
- **Ginza** – Is Tokyo's most famous up market shopping, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants and cafes. Also one of the most expensive, upscale areas in Tokyo which is jewelled with upscale retail like as Louis Vuitton, Chanel, Hermes, De Beers, Tiffany and Apple.
- **Naritasan** - (Naritasan Shinshoji Temple) is a large and highly popular Buddhist temple complex in Narita City, not far from Narita Airport. It is a great site to visit if you have three or more hours to spend around the airport and wish to catch a glimpse of historic Japan.
- **Odaiba** - is a popular shopping and entertainment district on a man-made island in Tokyo Bay. It originated as a set of small man made fort islands .
- **Diver City Tokyo Plaza** - is a shopping mall designed with the theme of creating a "theatrical city space." Its home to the world's only full-size Gundam statue and offers a wide selection of Japan-themed souvenirs at many of its shops. Diver City is a fun new destination in Tokyo for overseas visitors!

**IZU**

- **Chikurin no Komichi**- (Bamboo Forest Path) is at the right after crossing the Kaede Bridge. Surrounded by soldiers of bamboos shooting for the sky.
- **Tokko No Yu Foot Bath** - Izu area is Japan Wenquan Sheng yield of the land, only cobalt spa is Japan's most historic spa!
- **Hie Shrine** - was designated as a First Class Government Shrine before the Second World War, and was a highly respected place of worship for the people of Tokyo
